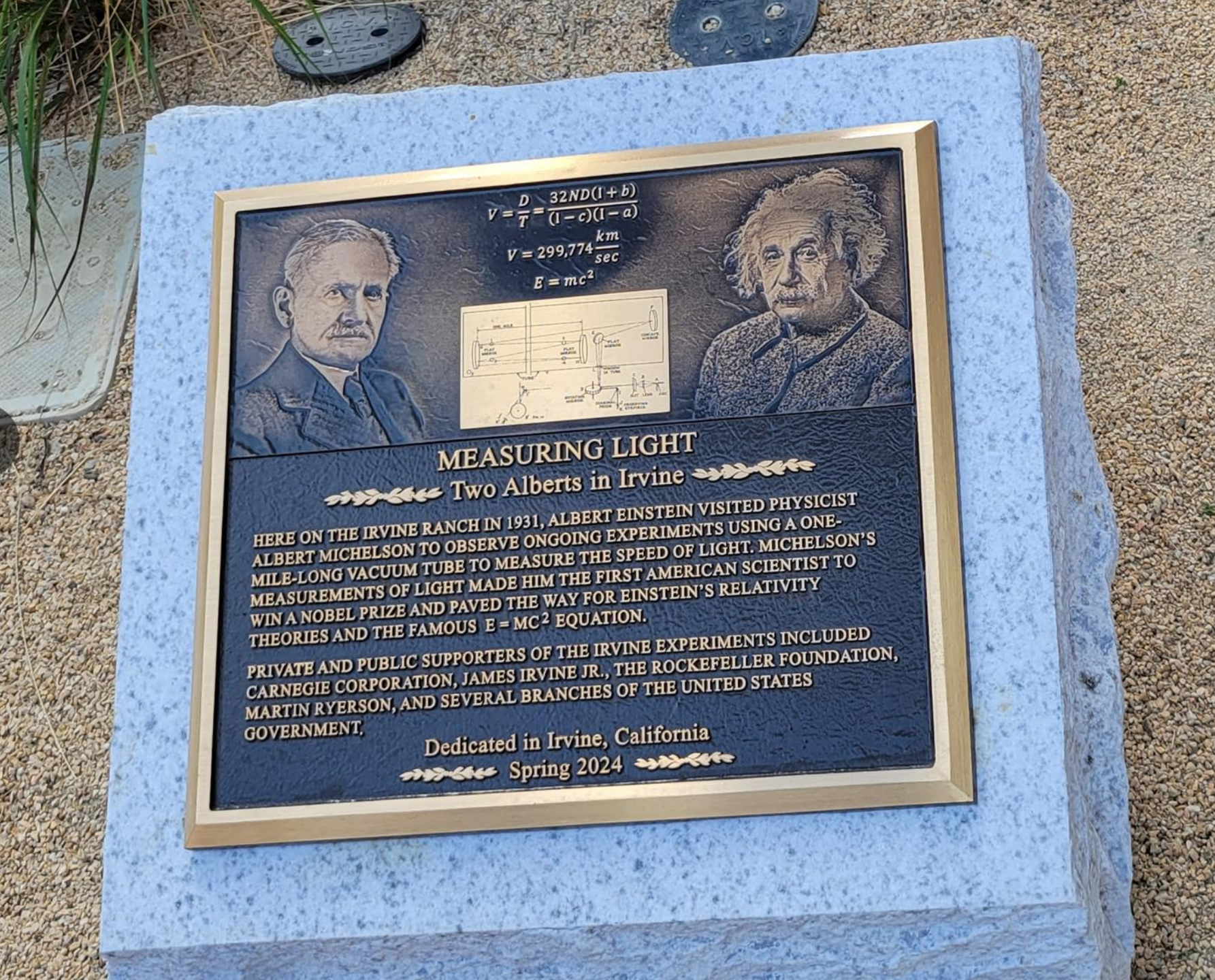


**Michelson Mile Marker Dedication

On June 18, 2024, the community gathered to unveil a monument at 1920 Main Street in Irvine honoring the work of Albert Michelson.

This monument commemorates Michelson's measurements of light that made him the first American scientist to win a Nobel Prize and paved the wave for Albert Einstein's relativity theories.
